This has certainly been an eventful year. In Myanmar, it has been especially lively in the major cities and border areas where the military seeks to violently impose their rule. Earlier this year, we mailed you a postcard requesting prayer for the nation and our staff. Please keep the nation in prayers, as the military's position has only hardened. Even in these difficult times we are pleased to report our staff are all safe and doing well.

Building continues at the Legacy Campus and the Legacy Learning Center without interruptions.

GOOD REPORTS:



The **Legacy Building** is taking shape and we are believing for completion by year's end. Currently, masonry work is finished on all three floors, both inside and outside. The carpenters have finished the windows and doors, with each one custom made of teak. The welders will begin installing banisters and stair railings in a few weeks. We will start painting during the cool season in November. There are many details to finish, but we are very pleased with the progress. One special point of interest: We have had over 250 workers and tradesmen working on this building and other projects. We have built a great relationship with these construction workers and they prefer to work on our projects when they have the opportunity. This favor has allowed us to speak into their lives with the Gospel!

Truly, the Lord has helped us! We look forward to training of thousands of students in the coming years. Our potential to reach the nations is exponential! We are strategically located for such a time as this! God has placed us here. Even through difficulties with the government and COVID, we know these delays are not His denials. When this is resolved, we will be stronger and in a better place to minister than ever before. I am reminded "preparation time is never wasted time." I have said this often: "We are a 'Beacon of Hope' to so many."

Angie's House has been such a blessing! These kids are loving everything about it! The safety and security of having a home and not having to deal with the threat of moving or having the rent raised are just two of the burdens lifted. The schools were closed for COVID and our kids are ready to get back to class. However, due to the recent increase in cases, schools will remain closed for the next few weeks.

One of the projects our kids are working on is their vegetable garden, and they have been growing vegetables like crazy. These lessons are valuable and teach them basic skills. They are producing enough to sell a small amount in the market. Another benefit is that it ensures they have a more balanced diet.

Jehovah Jireh Farms had a good harvest of sunflowers in the spring. In June, we planted a new crop of rice and it is starting to sprout. We are now in the middle of the rainy season, and with good rainfall we should have another great harvest. This farm will prove itself extremely valuable if there is any major fluctuations in the rice commodity market.
